Sir Sterling Moss - A Motoring Legend (1929 - 2020) - Trish Adams


Sir Stirling Moss, British racing driver and breaker of many land-speed records, died on April 12, 2020 at the age of 90, following a long illness. As you can see from the photo below he had a strong connection with MGs, and you can read more about that, and other aspects of his life in the fast lane, in the article in this <u>link</u>.

Moss reached an amazing 245.64mph in the tadpole shaped car, shattering the previous record of 203mph set by Goldie Gardner just before WW2.

The EX181 was a mid-engined machine built purely for speed. The pint-sized engine featured double twin cams and a supercharger, allowing it to reach 290bhp at 7,300rpm.

MG saw the marketing potential of being able to claim that it was the manufacturer of one of the fastest cars in the world at the time.

Today, the EX181 is displayed at the Motor Heritage Centre museum in the English Midlands.
