 - when house numbers reach 1000, turn RIGHT on Sunrise Drive and go 0.6 km (0.4 mi)
 - if you end up at Massassauga Point Conservation Area, you've missed the turn
 - LEFT on Sandy Cove Drive for 0.4 km (0.25 mi)

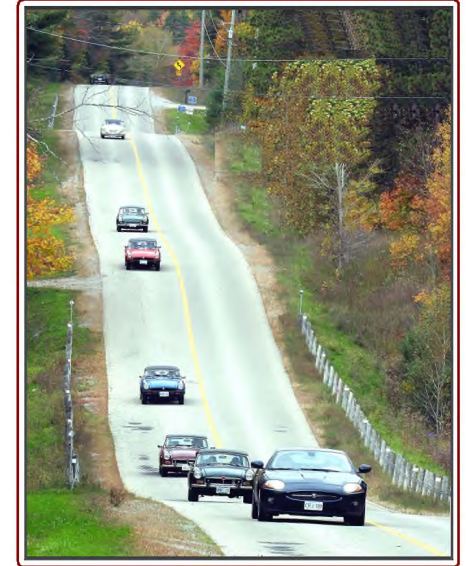
